



Improving health... changing lives

Project Access is a donated and coordinated network of healthcare services for the uninsured

Helping patients achieve wellness while reducing costs to the healthcare system.

Since inception over 1,200 patients have been enrolled in Project Access. We surveyed patients in 2010 before they received their care and asked about the quality of their health. Six months after their enrollment, we asked these patients the same questions. The results were impressive.

Achieving better health: Patients reported their health condition as Fair on average prior to receiving services. After their Project Access enrollment, patients reported that their health had improved to Good.

Reducing clinic visits: Patients surveyed self-reported that during the six months prior to their enrollment in Project Access, they visited their home clinics a combined total of 301 times due to poor health symptoms. After their enrollment in Project Access, patients had 110 visits to their home clinic, resulting in a 63% reduction in clinic usage.

Reducing ED usage and Hospital Stays: Patients surveyed self-reported that during the six months prior to their Project Access enrollment, they visited emergency departments a combined total of 50 times due to poor health symptoms. After their enrollment in Project Access, patients visited ERs a total of 12 times, resulting in a 76% reduction in ER usage.

Patients surveyed self-reported that during the six months prior to their Project Access enrollment they had hospital stays totaling 48 nights. After their enrollment in Project Access, they had hospital stays totaling five nights, a 90% reduction.

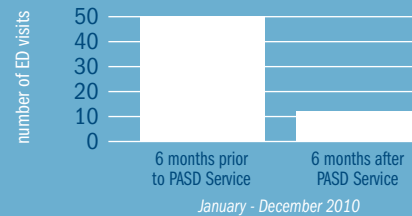

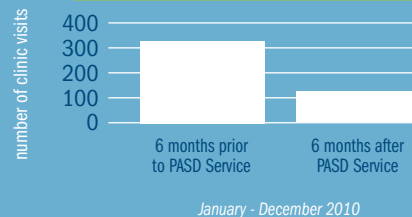
► PASD Patients have limited access to care

- 2% Seniors (55+)

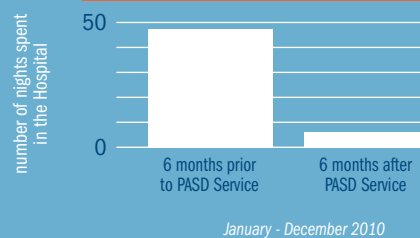
► Emergency Department Visits *Emergency Department Visits reduced by 76%*
