# \$50,000 grant to support health care services for the uninsured

The San Diego County Medical Society Foundation has received a \$50,000 grant from the S. Mark Taper Foundation, a private family foundation headquartered in Los Angeles, according to a release.

The grant will support the medical society's Project Access San Diego, designed to provide specialty health care services to the uninsured in San Diego County. Through this program, the San Diego County Medical Society Foundation has given more than \$4 million in donated surgical services and specialty care consultation to more than 1,300 uninsured patients since the program's founding in 2008. Project Access San Diego is supported by 10 hospitals, 14 surgery centers and more than 600 local specialist physicians. **Source Code: 20120202tga**
